KUHS – Academic – AYUSH – Governing Council Decision No. 89.53 – Nangelil Ayurveda Medical College, Ernakulam - Conditional Continuation of Provisional Affiliation 2026 - 27 – Action Ratified – Orders Issued.

ORDER

Vide notification read (1) above, the University invited applications from the affiliated colleges for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2026–27.

2. In response to the above notification, the Principal of Nangelil Ayurveda Medical College, Ernakulam submitted their application along with the required documents and remitted the prescribed fee.

3. The University conducted inspections at the college. The inspection report and the subsequent compliance report received from college were scrutinized by the Scrutiny Committee and noted that shortage of one lower faculty in the department of Shalakya tantra is still prevailing at the institution and other deficiencies were rectified. Accordingly, the committee recommended to grant Conditional Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the college for the academic year 2026–27.

4. Considering the urgency in forwarding the list of colleges to the Director of Ayurveda Medical Education (DAME) & the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) for the preparation of the seat matrix, and based on the recommendations of the Scrutiny Committee & the receipt of Letter of Permission received from the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), Government of India, Conditional Continuation of Provisional Affiliation was granted to Nangelil Ayurveda Medical College, Ernakulam for conducting UG-BAMS Course with the intake of 60 seats for the academic year 2026–27 subject to ratification by the Governing Council, with a condition that the shortage of lower faculty deficiency in the department of Shalakya Tantra to be rectified within one month.

5. Vide the paper read as (2) above, the Governing Council resolved to ratify the action taken in granting Conditional Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to Nangelil Ayurveda Medical College, Ernakulam for conducting UG-BAMS Course with the intake of 60 seats for the academic year 2026–27 subject to





rectification of above faculty deficiency within one month, and subject to the Letter of Permission from NCISM, Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India.

6. Vide paper read (3) above, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for the Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India has granted extended permission to Nangelil Ayurveda Medical College, Ernakulam with an intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

7. In the above circumstances, **orders are hereby issued ratifying the action taken in granting Conditional Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to Nangelil Ayurveda Medical College, Ernakulam for conducting UG-BAMS Course with the intake of 60 seats for the academic year 2026-27 with the condition that the shortage of lower faculty deficiency in the department of Shalakya Tantra to be rectified within one month.** The action taken in forwarding the seat matrix to the Director of Ayurveda Medical Education (DAME) & the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) for allotment process is also ratified.

8. The colleges shall strictly adhere to the conditions detailed below :-

- i. Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University / Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.
- ii. In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(C) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.
- iii. Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2026-27. The college has to apply for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the ensuing years by remitting the fee fixed by the University.
- iv. The college should remit Annual Administration Fee fixed for UG / PG Ayurveda courses for the academic year 2026-27, if applicable.
- v. Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.

9. Orders are issued accordingly.
